<u>Sub: Pension Revision for BSNL Pensioners</u>, in accordance with fitment formula given by the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC.

Dear Comrades,

The question of pension revision of BSNL Pensioners is the burning issue for all of us. Last time the pension revision was done as per 2<sup>nd</sup> PRC, which set the precedent for pension revision for BSNL Pensioners. But this time it looks uncertain due to application of affordability clause in BSNL. In view of that, we strongly feel that a joint approach is necessary for sorting out the pension revision issue once for all in accordance with fitment formula given by the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC.

This can be an acceptable solution keeping long term prospects in mind, because Govt. of India is extending all the main features of pay committee recommendations to BSNL Pensioners except the fitment formula. There should not be any major hitch on part of the Government to accept this proposition particularly when the weightage given by 7<sup>th</sup> CPC is slightly lower than that specified by 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC.

It may be more appropriate to take up this issue and persue the same through a joint forum of BSNL Pensioners. Hence, I am enclosing a draft letter addressed to MOC to be submitted jointly by four pensioner's Associations/ their joint forum. Kindly go through the letter and suggest any change if deemed appropriate. Once your consent will be available to us, we shall work out the process of taking signature and dispatch the same to Hon'ble MOC and others for n/a...
